While we didn't manage to make *ngalax* for our neighbours, we did enjoy an energetic celebration at a church that wasn't doing a sunrise service like ours was ;-). But the joy didn't end on Resurrection Sunday...

Thank you for praying for our **SIL Senegal retreat & conference**. In our retreat time, we considered what it means to be united with God and with His people: a vast topic for only two days! What did we take away from it?

Sarah: When I see a lack of fruitfulness in my life, meditating on Jesus' character will have more effect than trying harder!

John: The disciples walking on the road to Emmaus felt their hearts 'burning within them' as Jesus spoke, but it wasn't until they saw Jesus with their eyes that they recognized him (Luke 24). May I learn to recognize God by the burning in my heart rather than wishing my eyes could see Him.

As usual during Conference, we heard reports from around the country, as well as testimonies from our three newest members. One of them shared about how a single Bible verse (Matthew 4:4) convicted him, stuck in his head, and caused him to keep asking questions that eventually led him to give his life to Christ. - pray that each believer will be gracious with those around them and respond in a godly manner to any practical obstacles;

praise God that He is stronger than the enemy who always seeks to undermine or destroy this work, and pray that the teams will recognise His presence and know His protection;
ask God to give each participant health and stamina during the workshops, and to give John and Sheila rest in between;

pray for Him to sustain Sarah and give her joy whilst carrying a heavier load at home (especially during the second workshop, when John will be away for a week and a half)
pray for us to help our older children understand and engage with the work that our family is here to do.
