Dear friends,

What a privilege it is to support the 27 interns of the 2 Timothy 2:2 program for the 2025/26 cohort! As every year, we are deeply impressed by their commitment and humility in serving the Lord. During our first Zoom meeting of the year, Philip preached from Acts 6, reminding both trainees and mentors of the two essential pillars of ministry: the Word and prayer.

Our annual 2T22 retreat in January was also an opportunity to place a strong emphasis on prayer. There were 45 of us gathered together—singles, husbands, wives, and even a few babies. The teaching from Ephesians was especially rich, complemented by panel discussions and various workshops. Times of group discussion and prayer, as well as one-on-one conversations, were particularly meaningful and greatly appreciated by the trainees.



Each month, we meet on Zoom for training sessions to address various aspects of ministry. Harry Noël encouraged us to make evangelism a personal priority; Jonathan Meyer spoke about handling conflict and frustration in team settings; and Thomas Koning highlighted the importance of the doctrine of God's sovereignty in every area of our lives and ministries.

Discussions are always lively, as trainees are discovering firsthand the real challenges of ministry within the local church!

The eight interns from the Paris region also take part in the monthly 2T22 workshop, where they are required, among other things, to prepare sermons on the letter to the Philippians. These times are incredibly enriching, and we are seeing the benefits of a growing network of trainees who learn, sharpen, and support one another.

The 2T22 Days remain a key priority, allowing us to engage even earlier in the participants's process of reflection and discernment. Through these events, our desire is for every young person to consider how they can better serve Jesus. It is also an opportunity to highlight short-term internships and to share the diverse journeys of our speakers. We were in Lyon in November and in Grenoble on March 7.

Don't hesitate to spread the word about the 2T22 Days—the concept is still new, and we need everyone's help to demonstrate their value for every disciple of Christ.
