



Jurassic Coastal Walk – outline plan

The plan is to undertake a demanding walk spread over a few weeks on selected Fridays & Saturdays to provide a challenge and an opportunity to raise funds for charities that are close to my heart, and to give others the opportunity to join in this venture.

The walk is in 13 stages spread over 5 weekends on Fridays & Saturdays and 3 individual Saturdays, and totals just over 100 miles! No, I have not done anything like this before, but simply enjoy walking, especially along the Dorset coastal footpaths.

It is open for any, and all to join me, with no arrangements other than a starting location & time each day and a destination. There is no arranged support or transport, so all will be independent and responsible for their own travel arrangements, any overnight stop overs, food and safety. Whether folk join for a day, a 2 day walk, or all the walks does not matter – the choice is yours.

I am inviting folk from my sponsoring Rotary Club of Bournemouth East Cliff, my church friends from St Johns Wimborne, my family, the local Rotary clubs and churches from the surrounding Dorset area.

The **Dorset Historic Churches Trust** are supporting the initiative and are one of the three recipient charities.

The other charities I / we will be walking for are **Hope for Food** which provides food support in Bournemouth for those in need, and **CRUMBS** who train people with various life challenges in food & catering.

Funds will be handled through our Rotary Trust Fund Charity via the Just Giving page and 100% will go to the three charities. The JustGiving suggested fee can be avoided if the instructions are followed.
