

## Jurassic Coastal Walk: Experience 100 miles of the beautiful Dorset coastline

This is series of charity fundraising 1 or 2 day walks planned for local **Rotary** clubs, Dorset churches, family & friends, and others too, for, on an individual basis folk to join in at their own comfort & ability level. It may be that it is watching online from an armchair, or joining together at the start & finish to encourage those taking part, or joining us for one or part of one of the legs, or helping on the fundraising side.

A typical days walk will be 7 miles, some relatively easy, others much more strenuous!

I attach the itinerary and this will be the basis of the walks, although some details are yet to be confirmed.

Anyone will be welcome to join us for a days walk. There is no formal organisation intended, so every walker will be independent & self-sufficient. Travel arrangements will be an important part of this and as things develop then there may be connections made.
