Welcome Teams

Volunteers welcome for all services. This is a really good way of meeting the church family and being part of a team.

Volunteers always welcome for teams at all services.
Why not try it out one week to see if you like helping in this ministry.

Volunteers always welcome for all groups and activities - on Sundays or during the week.

Young People

Volunteers always welcome for all groups and activities - on Sundays or during the week.

Bookstall

Volunteers are welcome to join the team; the Bookstall is open between the morning services and once a month after the evening service.

Flower Arranging

Volunteers are always welcome to join the team, either for regular arranging of flowers for Sundays or for festivals, e.g. Christmas. Training and guidance can be provided.

Audio and Vision Teams

Volunteers welcome for all services.

Church Maintenance

Join in on our Saturday Maintenance to Mission Mornings - 3 times a year or join the team of those who help with small repairs and maintenance throughout the year.
